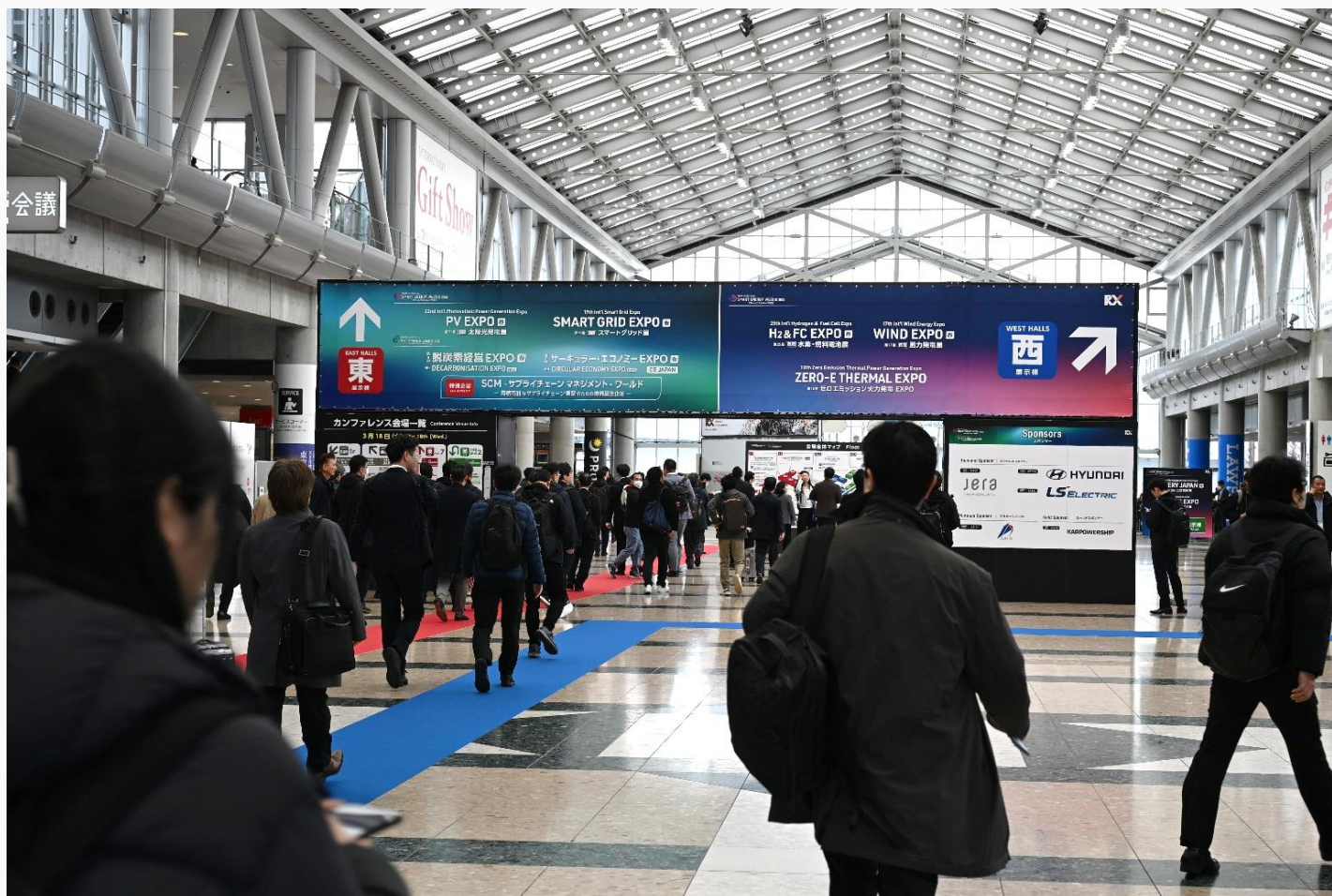

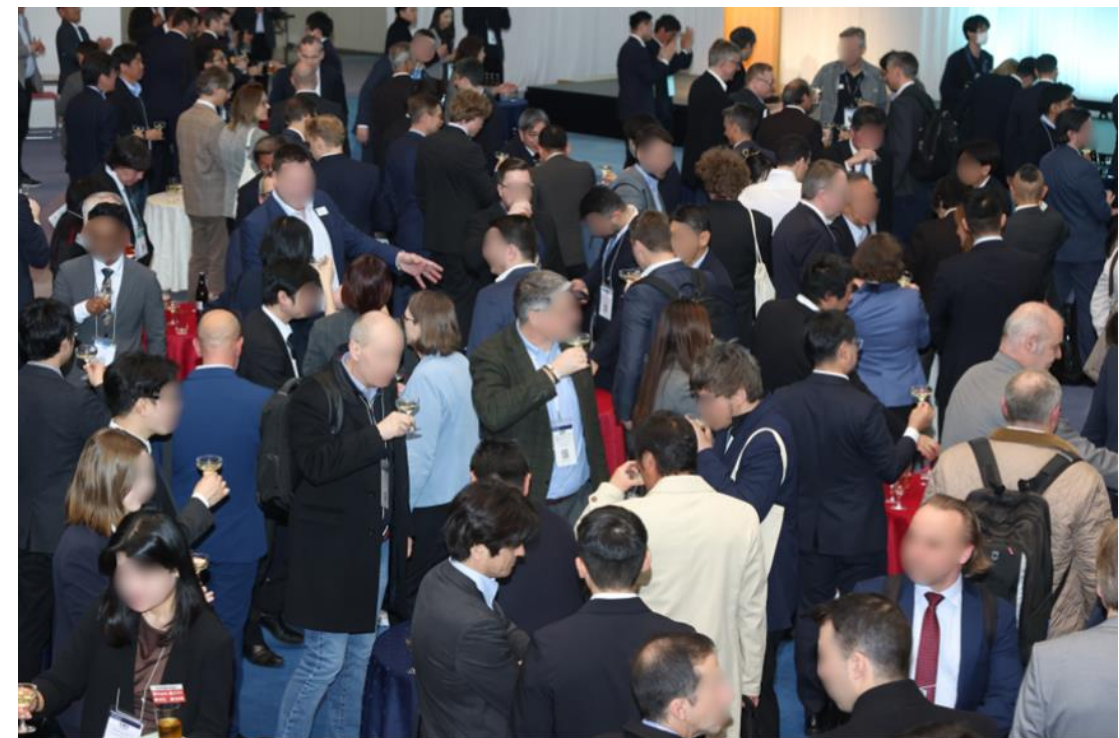
## EU-Japan Green Transition Reception
